# SUBMISSION AND PRESENTATION

#### Guidelines for submission of extended abstract

You are welcome to apply to the conference with a paper summary (around 300-400 words in total, up to 1 page). The purpose, methodology, results, theoretical contribution, practical implications (if applicable) of the research proposal should be indicated in the extended abstract. The extended abstract must be provided in the ICCC2017 template. The extended abstracts should be sent to email martynas.radzevicius@knf.vu.lt.



The notification of the acceptance will be provided after the submission. All authors of accepted extended abstracts are invited to conference and prepare final papers based on abstracts. A planned length of presentations is 15-20 min. followed by 10 min. discussions

## Guidelines for submission of papers

Extended abstracts will be published in an electronic collection of abstracts with ISBN, and selected conference papers <u>approved by peer review</u> will be published in electronic periodical <u>Culture and Creativity</u>. The final paper must be provided in the ICCC2017 template of the paper. Authors commit to prepare the paper strictly following the formatting and content guidelines provided in the template. The final paper should be sent to email <u>martynas.radzevicius@knf.vu.lt</u>.
